Alberta Fire Code Section 46(1)

The maximum occupant load for any room shall be calculated on the basis of the lesser of

- (a) the number of occupants determined in accordance with Table 3.1.14.A of the Alberta Building Code 1985, or,*
 - (b) the occupant load for which means of egress and exits are provided in section 44.*
- (2) The number of occupants permitted to enter a room shall not exceed the maximum occupant load calculated in conformance with subsection (1). See Sections 80(2), (3) and (4) of the Alberta Fire Code which specifies the required aisle and row arrangements*
