Because we are working with such small numbers, this could reflect one file with multiple people involved. Thefts of vehicles and theft from vehicles are the main issues seen in the area. Chevy trucks are currently the top most stolen. Community priorities remain the same as Enhance Road Safety, Contribute to Relationship Building and Enhance Awareness and Education. There are still some vacancies at the Constable level. This makes staffing difficult. Picture Butte has been selected as a satellite office for office work as it is well equipped and a central location. This will allow for more visibility with marked cars using the station. The Coaldale Detachment has also been approved for a two-person plain clothes division. One position will be a Town of Coaldale position and one position will be a provincial position. In closing, Staff Sargent Numan wanted to say how great of turn out the Coffee with a Cop was this year and that it should be an annual event.
