live in Picture Butte for 25 years.

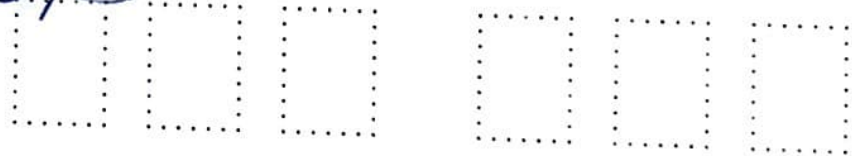

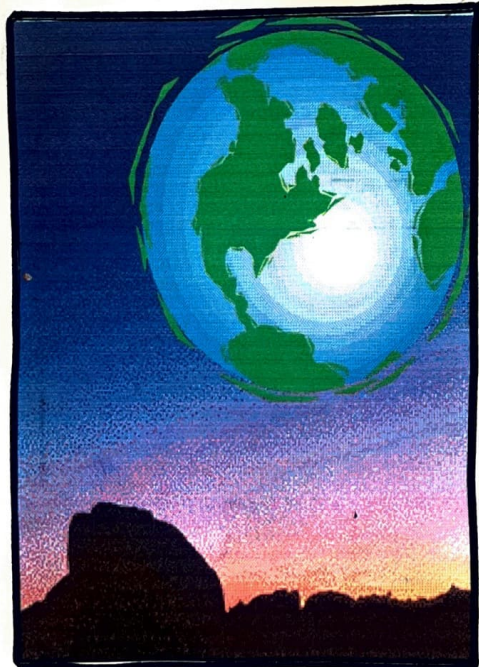

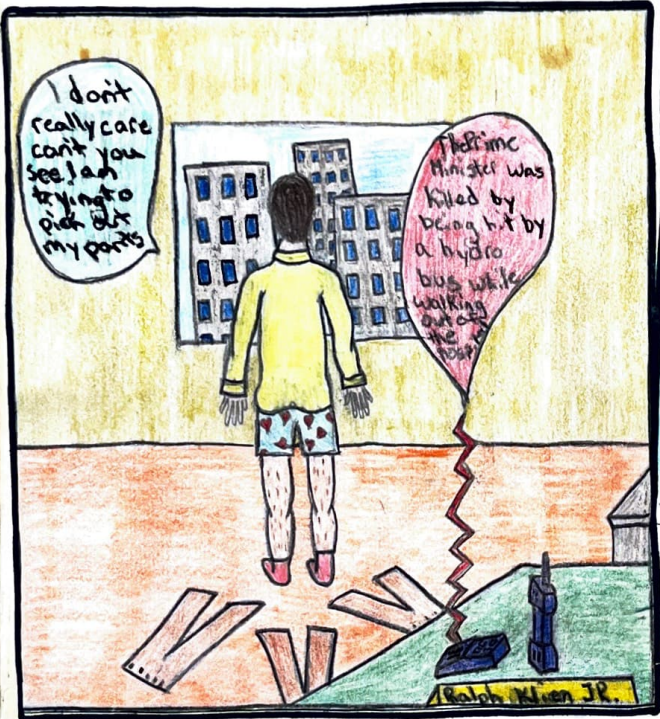

"Despite the negative response from the public about this new provincial tax the Legislature is still one hundred percent behind it," says Provincial Treasure Stockwell Night.

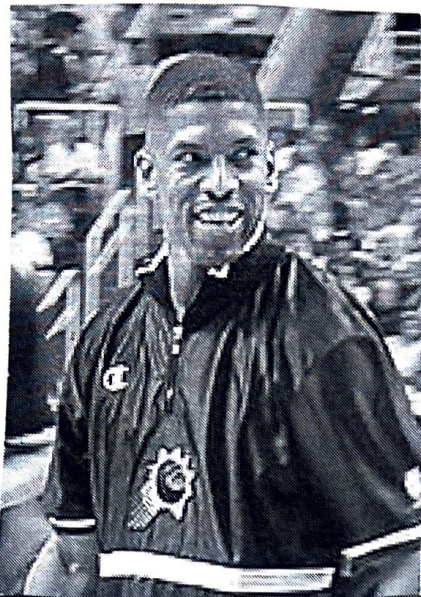
THE ROCK 2 DEAD AT 27

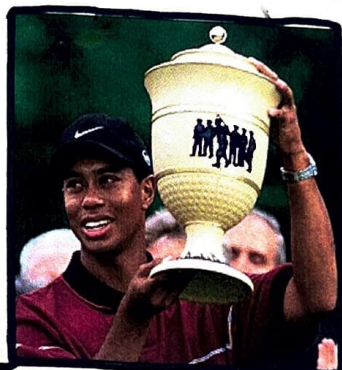

Tiger Duval Wins PGA Championship Despite Loosing His Head

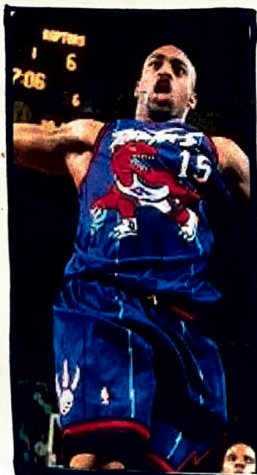

Jimmy was playing ball when Rover emerged from the bushes. That night Rover and Jimmy played fetch until three in the morning when they both fell

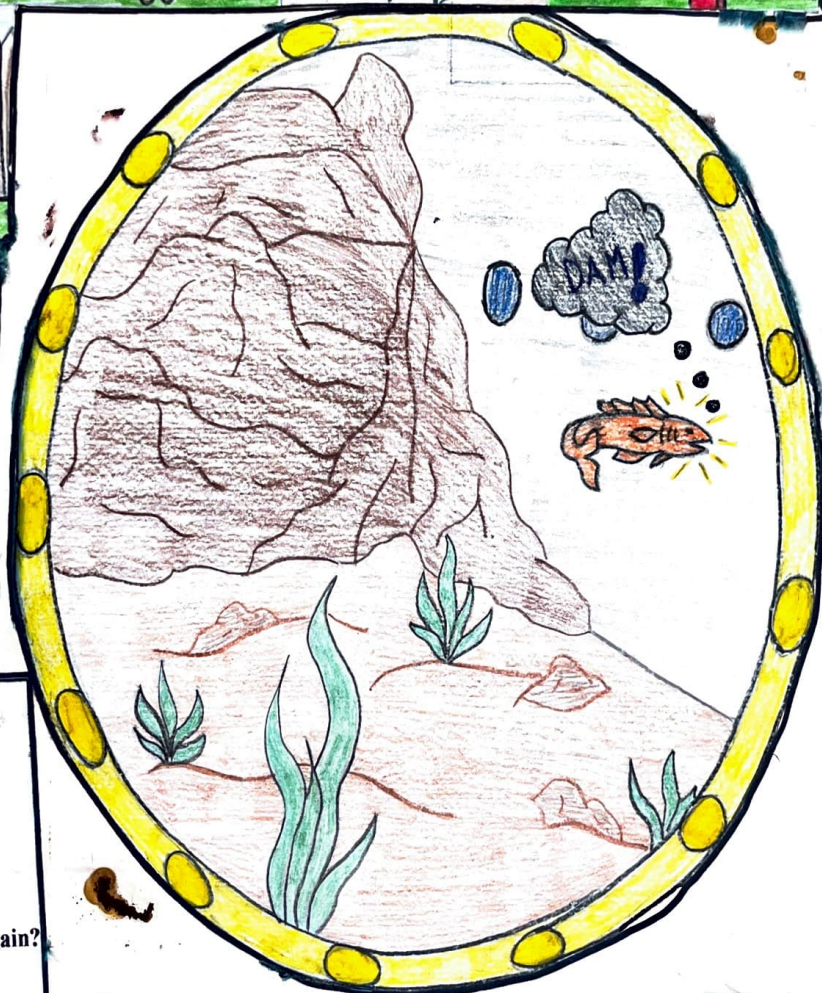
asleep on the lawn. "I thought they would never stop playing," said Bill Hoffarth, Jimmy's father.
